Construction will begin on Phase 1 of Memory Lane located in Woodlawn Cemetery beginning in April with an anticipated completion date of Memorial Day weekend. Phase 1 consists of moving the existing flagpole to the designated Memory Lane area and then completing a 20' by 20' portion of the brick walkway. ## SPRING CLEAN-UP DAY

Thinking of cleaning out the basement or garage soon? Well, you're in luck! Leslie Township's Spring Clean-Up Day is scheduled for **Saturday, May 7, 2011 from 8:30 - 11:00 a.m.**

Northwest Refuse will have several dumpsters and a compactor truck in the lower level parking lot for residents to load their refuse into. A new service offered on Clean-Up Day **only**, will be **Recycling Dumpsters** for cardboard (flattened), #1-7 plastics (rinsed; flattened), mixed paper and clear glass. These dumpsters will be located in the upper level parking lot.

**Please note: Clean-Up Day is for Leslie Township Residents only.**

Following is a list of materials that will be **prohibited** in the dumpsters:

1. Appliances containing Freon
  2. LP tanks
  3. Ignitable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic material
  4. Radioactive material
  5. Hazardous waste or containers with hazardous waste labels
  6. Liquid waste such as oils, solvents, paints, chemicals, pesticides, etc..
  7. Yard waste or compost material
  8. Tires (see below)
- ☼ Tire disposal will **not** be available at Spring Clean-Up. Northwest Refuse does accept tires at their Jackson facility. Call 787-3699 regarding tire disposal information.
  - ☼ Appliances with Freon coolant properly removed must be tagged in order to be accepted.
  - ☼ A scrap metal and car battery disposal service will be available at no charge.
  - ☼ For free removal of inoperable or junk vehicles call Mullins Auto Parts and Towing at 589-8543.
  - ☼ **Beautify your community by participating in Clean-Up Day.**
