Vickers reported five small trees were recently planted at the cemetery. The next Woodlawn Cemetery Association meeting will be in January.

Eldred reported a quiet month for the fire department.

A written zoning report was presented. No building report for the previous month.

Charles Lawson from Clark Hill PLC representing the Ingham County Treasurer's Office was in attendance to take several questions regarding the Malch and Davis properties. He stated the tax revolving fund is solvent and he was confident that the Ingham County Treasurer would be willing to work with Leslie Township. Attorney Lawson will address our questions to the Ingham County Treasurer and get back with us.

Dallas Henney, Leslie Township Deputy Supervisor, addressed the board regarding his meeting with Safety Clean. Safety Clean has removed

all the chemicals and contaminants from the Malch property. There was a mercury issue discovered during the clean-up and a \$1,900 upcharge will be assessed to the township. Brian Stetler will be demolating the dangerous buildings on the Malch property as soon as Consumers Energy removes the power source.

Motion Vickers, support Wade to appoint Megan Casper as an alternate to the March Board of Review. This appointment will expire on December 31, 2016. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Correspondence was received from Enbridge regarding a safety update, Communities in Schools asking for a donation, Tristen Streeter regarding construction of a proposed flag retirement box for his Eagle Scout project, a thank you to Wolverine Sealcoat for painting our handicap parking areas at no charge and grant information from the Brownfield Redevelopment Authority.

Vickers and Feazel reported attending a parks and trails meeting. At the meeting it was disclosed that the local units will be responsible for maintaining and policing any trails or parks developed in their township.
