Eldred reported a fire training and appreciation dinner will be held on September 17th. He also reported a 1 ton pick up truck has recently been purchased and interviews are being held for three open positions on the department.

Symonds reported three (3) inspections.

Calhoun reported since the Ingham County Sheriff's Office is not willing to enforce our ordinances by issuing a citation we have created a form letter to replace the citation in the event of a zoning ordinance violation (such as an unauthorized mud bog event). Our attorney states our ordinances are set up to make it a criminal offense as well as a civil offense. We also have the option to set up a municipal bureau with a code enforcement officer but it is not recommended for a unit our size.

The upcoming planning commission public hearing and a used car lot in violation of our zoning were discussed during comments.

It was reported fall clean-up day is scheduled for October 12, 2013. The Board agreed to extend the monthly recycling for an additional nine months.

Correspondence was received from the Mid-Michigan Program for Greater Sustainability regarding funding for non-profit organizations and Granger regarding recycling questions.
