## SPRING CLEAN-UP & RECYCLING DAY

Spring Clean-Up & Recycling Day is Saturday, May 20, 2023 from 8:30 – 11:00 a.m. at Leslie Township Hall. The recycling service will be located in the upper-level parking lot. The following items will be accepted in the recycling bin Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs & containers (rinsed & flattened), tin and aluminum (rinsed and flattened), mixed paper (newspaper, magazines, phone books, junk mail), cardboard (**flattened**), clear & all colors of container glass; food & beverage bottles.

Several dumpsters and a compactor truck will be located in the lower-level parking lot. Following is a list of materials which will be <u>prohibited</u> in the Clean-Up dumpsters:

- 1. Appliances containing Freon unless officially tagged that Freon was removed
- 2. LP tanks
- 3. Ignitable, corrosive, reactive, or toxic material
- 4. Radioactive material
- 5. Hazardous waste or containers with hazardous waste labels
- 6. Liquid wastes such as oils, solvents, paints, chemicals, pesticides, etc.
- 7. Yard waste or compost material
- 8. Tires (EXCEPTION: motor vehicle tires cut in half will be accepted)
- \* The scrap metal disposal service will be available
- \* For free removal of inoperable or junk vehicles call Mullins Auto Parts 589-8543.

\*\* Note: Clean-Up Day is a week later than in previous years \*\*

The recycling bin will also be available the second weekend in May
